

...Parent Liaisons are there to help teachers, administrators and all support staff build a more effective relationship with families.


## - Who We Are -

# The Goal of the Parent Liaison Project

To provide information and guidance for parents navigating the Exceptional Student Education (ESE) process, as well as information about community resources for families by:

- Emphasizing and strengthening family roles and responsibilities in the education process.
- Enhancing partnerships
   between schools and
   community support services.
- Strengthening home-school relationships by facilitating positive pro-active communication between families and educators.
- Increasing awareness of family issues and concerns in schools and communities.



### ...And Some Things We Do...

- Provide families with information and guidance on how to access educational and community services via printed and electronic newsletters.
- Provide individual assistance to parents regarding Individual Education Plan (IEP) process.
- Offer workshops/training and materials on educationally relevant topics.
- Participate in district/agency committees to provide parent of exceptional student perspective.
- Provide assistance to schools implementing parent involvement strategies for parents of exceptional students.
- Promote and participate in monthly FDLRS/Early Childhood Council Developmental screenings.
- Participate in weekly Early Steps,
   Part C transition meetings.
